Our Mission: Community Ministry of Prince George's County (CMPGC) is an interfaith 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization and community health resource that is committed to helping meet human service needs, close the educational achievement gap and reducing health inequities that exist in various communities.

Human Services Programs and Ministries

Answer Center Program: Our doorway to assistance and referral services. Community Ministry listens to and offers referral or assistance to requestors who are seeking information and/or assistance to address a food, housing, utility, or other crisis.

Step-Up Housing Assistance Program: CMPGC' receives requests and provides referrals and assistance for housing support. The program seeks to avoid the disruptions that accompany housing evictions and to help reduce homelessness.

Community Place Café Food Assistance Program: CMPGC and Community Place Café Food Assistance Program (CPC FAP) partners provide 161 food insecure people, including homeless and near homeless people, supermarket gift cards consistently.

We Do Care Outreach Program: Our community outreach team distributes monthly 52,000 lbs. of fresh produce to about 1,000 families from sites in Oxon Hill, Seat Pleasant, and two (2) in Capitol Heights, MD. The team also distributes seasonal holiday food baskets, clothing, and gifts to needy families and children.

Health Education, Research, and Health Care Services Support

Project Health LEAP Supported by the Prince George's County Health Department, Project LEAP educates people who live in Prince George's County about the COVID-19 virus. Project LEAP helps participants get the health and social services that they and their family members need. CMPGC assists individuals in enrolling in the program.

Partnering for Vaccine Equity Project, supported by CDC Foundation, educate and encourage COVID-19 and Influenza vaccine acceptance in Edgecombe County, NC.

Choose Life – Stop Smoking! Supported by The Maryland Center at Bowie State University, provides tobacco education and outreach to communities in Prince George's County.

Stop the Violence; Save Our Leaders project provides youth and associated adults with researched youth violence prevention and leadership development awareness messaging.
