Easterseals Homeless Veterans Reintegration Programs (HVRP) help homeless veterans build a foundation for finding and keeping long-term employment.

- Counseling and placement services
- Assistance with Veterans Administration benefits, health issues, and housing

homeless veterans reintegration program (HVRP)

Ensures that homeless veterans receive the support and services they need to address the more complex needs they often face. HVRP also connects incarcerated veterans with appropriate employment and life skills support as they transition from correctional facilities into the community.

homeless female veterans and veterans with families program (HFVWF)

Provides supportive services to eligible female veterans who are at risk of becoming homeless.

service areas

- Washington, DC
- Maryland Counties: Anne Arundel, Baltimore City, Baltimore, Calvert, Cecil, Harford, Howard, Prince George's, Montgomery, and St. Mary's
- Virginia Counties: Alexandria, Arlington, Fairfax, Loudon, and Prince William



eligibility

- Must be a homeless veteran or at risk of homelessness
- Must provide proof of veteran status (i.e. DD214 member form 4)
- Must have received any type of discharge status other than dishonorable
